



## Dutch Dance Inclement Weather Policy

"All Dutch Dance performances will take place rain or shine."

### Tulip Time Policy – Dutch Dancer “rain gear”

1. We recommend purchasing an inexpensive rain poncho so you will have it available in the case of heavy rain. This is for your comfort and to protect your costume.
2. Only clear ponchos are acceptable.
3. Dancing without a rain poncho is always the goal and most desirable as it makes a more pleasing presentation for our guests.
4. Costume directors will collectively make the decision, on site, regarding whether or not weather conditions warrant wearing the poncho during performances.
5. Wearing the clear rain poncho around town, on a rainy day, is the decision of the individual dancer.

### Zuid Beveland Dancers

1. The Zuid Beveland outer hat should not be worn in the rain.
2. If weather is questionable, please take a plastic bag or container along to protect the hat.
3. The costume directors will decide collectively whether the hats should be worn or removed for a performance and it will be announced.
4. The undercap and “kissers’ should be worn at all times, rain or shine.
5. This is the only hat that is removed for inclement weather conditions.

### Tulip Time reserves the right to cancel any performance due to threatening weather.

1. Performances may be cancelled prior to performance if weather becomes severe and travel dangerous.
2. In the case of questionable circumstances, the final decision to travel and/or perform is ultimately the dancer’s and/or parent’s choice.
