

BOY'S URK COSTUME - pg. 5

* Key details that we look for at inspection:

1. Overall appearance of costume
2. Do you have the fur-like hat with blue interior facing? Ties can be worn in front or back
3. The red collar does not droop but stands and follows the jacket neck edge.
4. Black scarf finished width 1-1/2 inches wide is tied in a sailor's knot
5. The ring (which represents your wedding ring) is worn on the right side of the scarf.
6. Jacket shoulder extends 2 inches off the shoulder
7. Sleeve length is to the first knuckle of the thumb.
8. Sleeve cuff is worn down, not turned back.
9. Jacket front crosses left over right, is tucked into the pants the top right buttonhole is set at an angle and the buttonhole on the left side is straight across but horizontal.
10. Third button is 1" from the top of the waistband and the 2nd is in the middle of the first and third. The fourth set does not show, it is inside the pants.
11. Pants length is below the fullest part of the calf, having a double 1" hem
